WHO IS SHE?

Giulia Mazzoni is a trailblazing pianist and composer, celebrated for redefining contemporary classical music through her fusion of romanticism and modernity. Trained at the prestigious G. Verdi Conservatory in Milan, she has been hailed as the heir of Michael Nyman, with whom she collaborated, and is a leading voice in the "New Classical" movement. Renowned for her deeply emotional pianism, Mazzoni's artistry is marked by a delicate yet powerful touch that evokes profound emotions, from introspection to unbridled joy. Her compositions, rich in poetic nuance and depth, invite listeners on a sonic journey forging a personal connection with her audience and highlighting her artistic sensitivity. Mazzoni's discography includes three acclaimed albums: Giocando con i Bottoni, Room 2401 (Sony), and YAS Your Anima System (Ada/Warner), produced by 16-time Grammy-winning producer Thom Russo. She has graced the stages of the world's most prestigious theaters, earning critical and public acclaim, particularly in China. Breaking new ground in the classical scene, she was the first composer to introduce an innovative instrumental genre to an Italian operatic institution, performing as a featured artist at the Maggio Musicale Fiorentino. Most recently, she composed and performed the soundtrack for Anna, a film by Marco Amenta that premiered at the Venice Film Festival and garnered numerous international awards, further solidifying her reputation as a visionary artist in contemporary music.

The setlist weaves original compositions with unique reinterpretations of iconic pieces such as Space Oddity by David Bowie and Truman Sleeps by Philip Glass, bridging the gap between tradition and innovation, classical and contemporary. Among the most powerful moments, Wildness, the main theme from the soundtrack of Anna (a film by Marco Amenta, premiered at the Venice Film Festival), and Artemisia, a tribute to female strength and resilience, inspired by the legendary painter Artemisia Gentileschi,


